## Social Contact



1 household / bubble in most locations, indoors and outdoors. Rule of six applies in some outdoor settings like parks, public gardens and sports courts.

## Weddings and Funerals



Up to 15 guests for weddings and up to 30 guests for funerals, 15 for wakes and related ceremonies. Wedding receptions not permitted.

## Overnight Stays



Those in area advised against overnight stays in other parts of UK. People outside area advised against overnight stays in area.

## Working from home guidance



Work from home where possible.

## Shopping and Retail



Open.

## Leisure and gyms



Any closures or additional restrictions subject to consultation.

## Hospitality



Pubs and bars must close except where they operate as a restaurant, meaning they can only serve alcohol with a substantial meal. Further closures subject to consultation.

## Entertainment and tourist attractions



Any closures / additional restrictions subject to consultation. Nightclubs and adult entertainment remain closed.

## Education



Schools, FE colleges open. Universities must reflect wider restrictions with option to move to greater online provision.

## Healthcare Services



Open.

## Residential Care



Closed to external visitors other than in exceptional circumstances.

## Travel and Transport



May continue to travel to open venues, but reduce number of journeys where possible. Avoid travel where possible in or out of the affected area with exceptions including work and school.

## Sporting Activity



Organised sport / licensed physical activity allowed in outdoor settings. Indoor organised sport must follow social contact rules (other than youth or disabled sport).

## Worship



Open, subject to social contact rules.

## Childcare



Registered and wraparound childcare. Supervised activities permitted in private homes. Children's groups permitted. Childcare bubbles for under 14s.

## Youth Clubs and Activities



Permitted.

There are three simple actions we must all do to keep on protecting each other:



### Wash hands

keep washing your hands regularly



### Cover face

wear a face covering in enclosed spaces



### Make space

stay at least 2 metres apart - or 1 metre with a face covering or other precautions

# CHRISTMAS AT HOME

## with Rochester Cathedral

This trail is an adaptation of one originally set in the High Street of Rochester and has been designed for you to create your own trail at home, indoors or outside.

Alternatively, you can sit quietly and simply watch one video after the other.

This sequence takes you through a story which has been told every year at Christmas for many, many years. The nativity story tells us something very special about God, that God loved his people so much that he was prepared to be with us and to live among us.

Suitable for all ages.

You will need

- a smartphone with QR reader (most modern cameras on smartphones will read QR codes)
- 3 sheets of plain paper
- scissors

Begin by printing the pdf called **christmas-cards.pdf** onto plain A4 paper.

Cut the sheets along the dotted lines to create 12 individual cards.

Place the cards around the house (or garden) to create your own trail.

Scan each code, listen and join in as much as you want to (words to carols are provided in each video) and then move onto the next part of the sequence.

We hope you will enjoy it, and experience a virtual journey.

The Christmas Cards for this trail are printed on the back pages.

- Choose 3 members to light the 3 candles (engage all ages)

**Reflection time:** When was the last time you heard something that made you happy – what was the announcement? Were you expecting the news/announcement or was it a complete shock? If you were writing a newspaper or news article what would the headline be?

Share with those who you are gathered with the Headlines you can try to make them "funny", "shocking" or "intriguing"

When the angel appeared before Mary telling her she was to have a son and call him Jesus she was shocked, nervous, and fearful – what would the headline be for this news story? However, the angel reassured Mary that God's Holy Spirit would be with her and she was very capable of what was being foretold, good things can come in surprises or announcements - Wonderful things do come in surprises when God is involved, because God has the power to deliver them.

Now is the time to light the first, second, third & fourth candle on an advent wreath if you have one; or colour the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> candle below. As you light or colour the candles you could use the **Text Overlay** prayer on the next sheet. The fourth candle reminds us of Love & Peace – the Angels candle.

## Interactive Learning.....

This picture will be on the sheet every week during Advent – Today's candle is **LOVE** but don't forget to colour the previous 3 candles reminding us of God's HOPE, PEACE & JOY.



**Text Overlay** – Read the prayer below several times. Draw the images or a picture that comes into your minds when reading the prayer through. Finally, in a dark colour write the prayer over the top of the image/drawing. Place in a prominent place for everyone to see.

People of God: awake!  
The day is coming soon  
when you shall see God face to face.  
Remember the ways and the works of God.  
God calls you out of darkness  
to walk in the light of his coming.  
You are God's children.

## Love Lantern

On a sheet of paper create messages of love, who you love and how you can show love to friends & family just as Mary did as she expressed her love & faith in God by responding "Here I Am" Then create lanterns with the paper.



## Will You Risk It Challenge?

Over the Christmas holidays take up the Risk It Challenge when you can. Set risks/challenges like "say to 3 people this week that God cares for them too" or "It's a special day, and you're a special person." I'm sure you will think of other examples to share your faith & love in Jesus.

As we approach Christmas day, we wait with hope for the one who has already come. On the first Christmas, Christ entered the world, laying his glory down to dwell among us. He is Emmanuel, God with us; our hope, our comforter, our safe refuge and our Saviour.

**Despite the challenges 2020 has brought, our God has been faithful.** We wanted to take a moment to pause and remember how God has been with us and share some of this year's blessings with you.

Through our Global Coronavirus Response, we have been able to reach 1.5 million people, installing 1,788 hand washing stations and distributing 83,476 hygiene kits to the most vulnerable areas in the world.

We are so thankful for the donations we have received during this time, from individuals and churches. It's been amazing to see God's faithful provision.

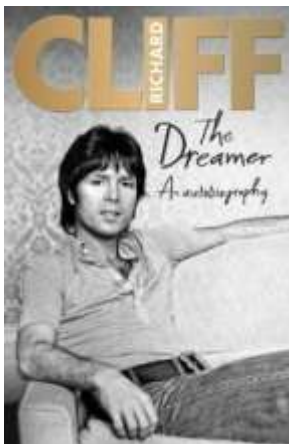

### More Than Words by Hannah Dunnett

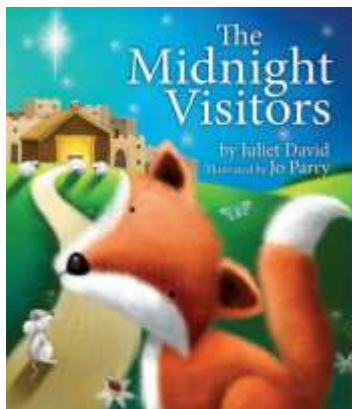

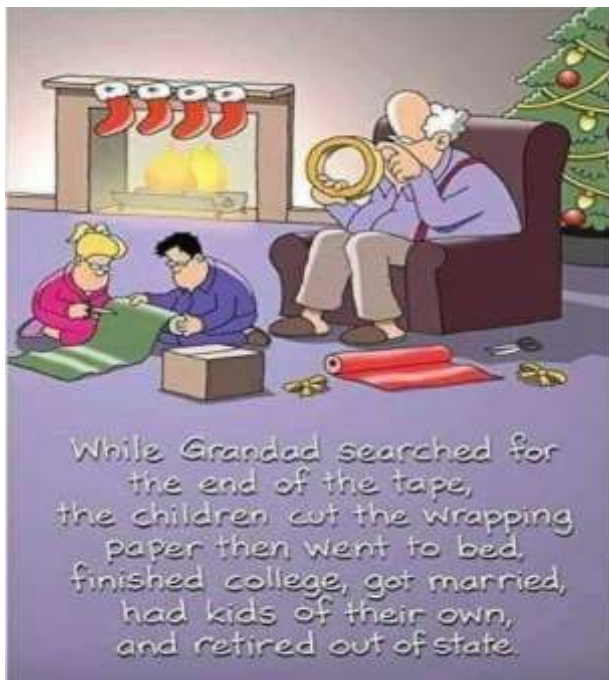

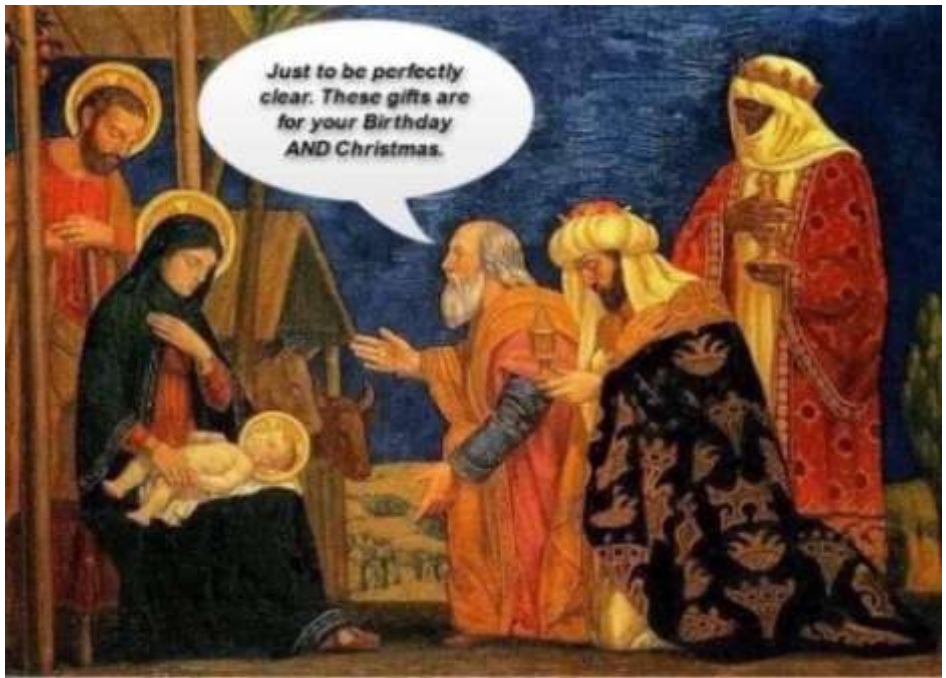
